

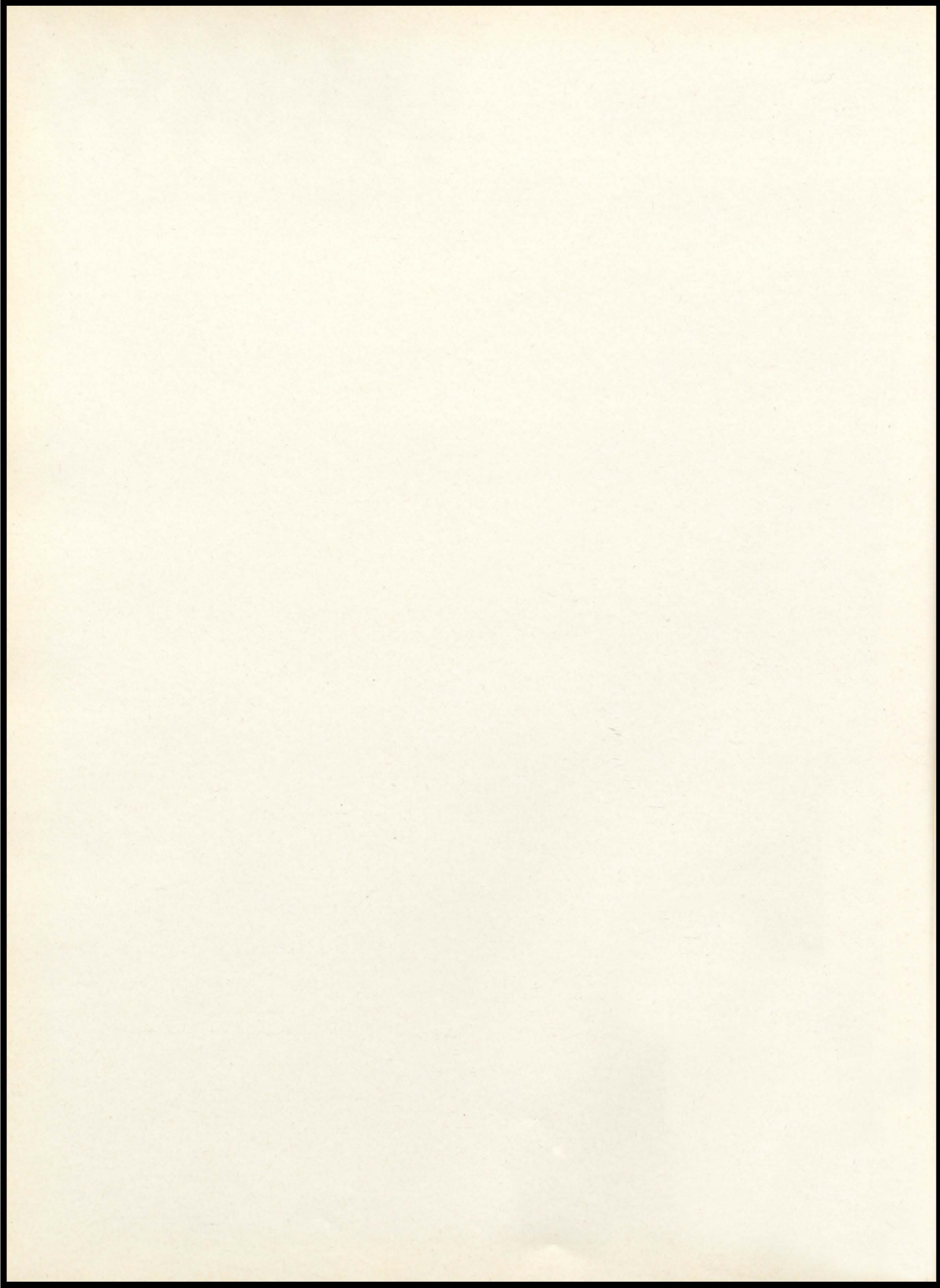

Miss Kazebeer's guidance has assisted many students further their education in algebra, geometry, and trigonometry. In addition, she serves as advisor of Y-Teens.

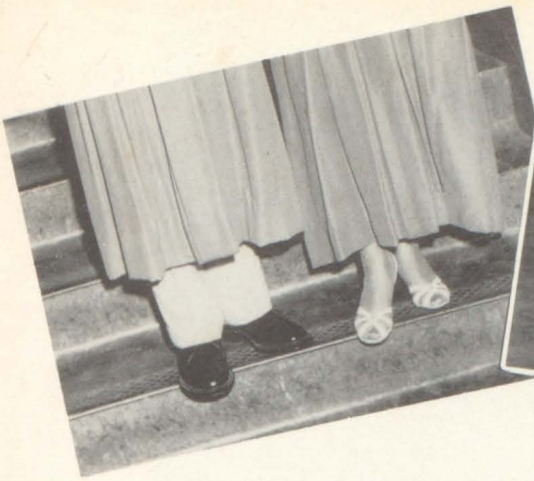
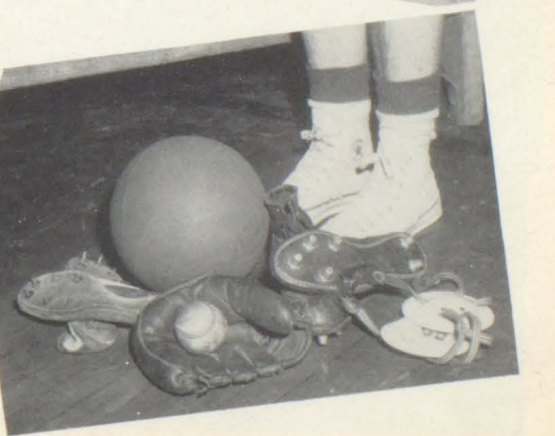

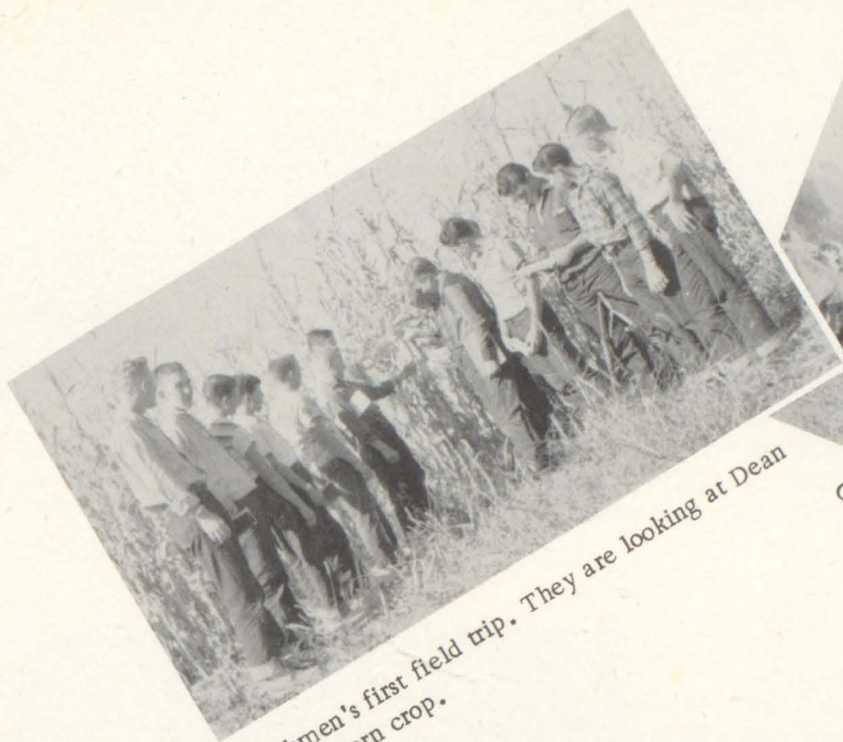

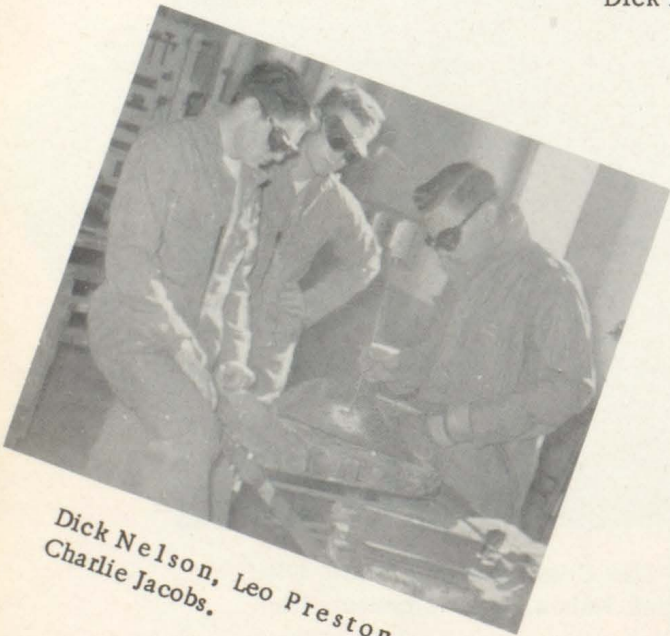

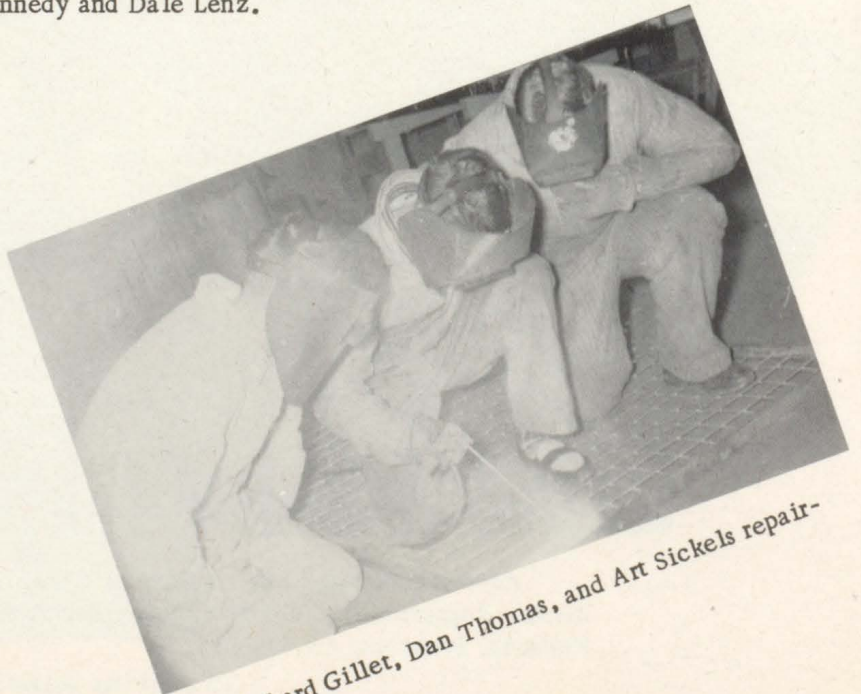
